Each summer, I chose a topic to explore at Shabbat services instead of a formal sermon. Last summer, we examined our new *Machzor—Mishkan Henefesh*. In previous years I have chosen to discuss Jewish Humor, weekly Haftarah portion (instead of the Torah portion) and Jewish Women Suffragettes to name just a few. This summer, I found I was unable to settle on just one topic, so I thought I would introduce a variety of unusual and I hope interesting subjects in this year's Summer Pulpit Series I am calling *Other Jewish Topics*. I will encourage your participation by asking you questions and generally soliciting your comments. This past Shabbat, we discussed Jewish Superstitions, and I learned a lot from my research and from you. I enjoyed our discussion, and I think those present did as well.

Summer is a great time to change things up a bit, and our service time and "vibe" will change too. We encourage less formal dress, so leave those neckties, jackets and other formal wear at home. Instead of 7:00 PM services with Oneg Shabbat following, we will gather at 6:00 PM for refreshments and then prayers at 7:00 concluding with the Candle, Kiddush and Challah blessings. We can arrive in daylight and depart in daylight and enjoy a relaxing Shabbat dinner once we return home or with fellow congregants at any number of area eateries.

Judaism does not stop in the summer, it just put on shorts, Hawaiian shirts and sunglasses (in a matter of speaking.)

(I will be away the first Shabbat in July, but I'll see you all on July 7 and then I hope on July 8 for more summer fun at our Comedy Night.)

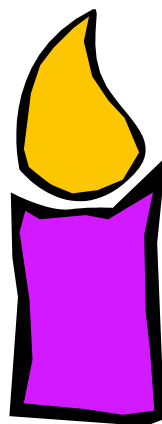
